

THE SOL BASELINE OVERVIEW

Each unit page has five structured tabs and an unlimited number of additional tabs which you can use with your curriculum. Each tab has some guidance embedded into the page to help and inspire in its completion. Below are the key elements you should ensure are present in each tab on a unit page.

Overview Tab

- Welcome message from the unit leader
- Learning Outcomes
- Teaching and Learning Strategy
- Outline weekly scheme of work to manage expectations

Assessment Tab

- Assessments Briefs
- Clear plain English description of assessment requirements
- Marking criteria or rubrics
- Online submission upload links or physical submission instructions
- Optional extra – Video assessment brief

Reading and Resources Tab

- Reading List – send to library
- Subject specific supporting resources
- Links to subject guides, discipline related videos

Keep in Touch Tab

- Discussion boards - used to disseminate unit information and give students the opportunity to ask and answer questions, reflect, problem solve, or engage in other higher-order thinking skills
- Tutor contact details (or link to profile) and office hours
- Clearly managed expectations of frequency and methods used for replying to students
- A clear tutor 'presence' throughout SOL

- Links to relevant academic skills support such as specific succed@solent resources
- Links to relevant digital capability support such as Lynda.com
- Links to relevant employability support such as CareerBox
